Time Commitment

Board roles typically require:

- Approx. 3 hours per month
- Inclusive of reading over Board papers and attendance at our monthly board meetings the second Monday of the month 10am-12noon (mostly virtual)
- Scheduled sub-committee meetings, strategic planning sessions and other meetings as required.

As a board member, you will:

- Attend regular board meetings and review relevant materials
- Bringing views and opinions to the Board table
- Provide input into ACEVic's strategic planning and decision-making
- Review financial statements and organisational policies
- Act as an ambassador for ACEVic within the ACE sector
